Representatives on the school board (Conseil d'Établissement - CE) and official committees. Joint-list with the parent's committee (Elterbeirat) of the primary school.

The APELM presents the list of candidate parent delegates (from among its members) to the Management for validation and official appointment.

APELM members can participate in working groups on a regular or ad-hoc basis.
